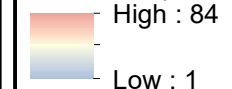

Zone of Theoretical Visibility (ZTV)

This ZTV has been run using points at 50m intervals along the access track, with a height of 4m above the track representing the height of vehicles during construction. Therefore, it shows an over-estimation of potential visibility as it is unlikely that vehicles would be present at all points of the access track simultaneously (see Appendix 7.1)

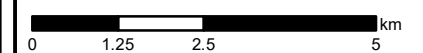
